Critical thinking: thinking deeper about any subject, content, or problem. This is done by breaking it down into smaller pieces in order to really understand a topic.

<b>Solves problems and makes decisions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It can be hard to figure out what the problem is.</li> <li>• I make a quick decision without thinking about other choices.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I know what the problem is</li> <li>• I can give simple solutions to a problem</li> <li>• I think about my choices and then make a decision.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I know what the problem is and can explain it in detail</li> <li>• I can come up with several solutions to the problem and give reasons why these are good possible solutions.</li> <li>• I can make a decision and explain my choice.</li> </ul>
